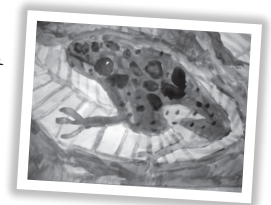


### 301 MASKMAKING: *Spirits of the Rainforest*
