## MORNING CLASSES: 8:30-11:45 AM

### PUPPETRY Mandela's South Africa

Nelson Mandela is one of the world's most beloved and admired heroes. Born in a small village in South Africa in 1918, he became the first black president of South Africa in 1994. Learn about this great humanitarian and Nobel Peace Prize winner. Listen to the stories and African folklore he heard as a young boy told by elders in his village. Then work with an artist to create your own puppet and perform your favorite story as a group.



### MUSIC African Idiophones

Idiophones are self-sounding instruments that are struck, shaken, or scraped and found in all cultures around the world. Instruments like rattles and shakers are made from a variety of materials. Some idiophones like the xylophone and thumb piano are tuned. All are important in African culture and music making. Work with an artist to create a variety of African idiophones and play them as accompaniment in the puppet performance.

### DRAWING & PAINTING A Wildlife Safari

You will not want to miss this wildlife safari! South Africa is home to some of the world's most magnificent and diverse wildlife from the African lion to the hippopotamus to the ostrich. Work with artist Karen Anderson to draw and paint your favorite animal of South Africa, as you learn new drawing and painting skills and techniques using a variety of art materials.



### AFRICAN DRUMMING/DANCE Soul of a Community

The drum is the heartbeat, the soul of most African communities. Join master drummer, Fode Bangoura, and dancer, Whitney McClusky, of Duniya Drum and Dance Ensemble as they introduce African drumming and dance. Practice hand techniques, patterns and rhythms on the drum. Then respond to the dynamic energy of the drum through dance-a true call and response.

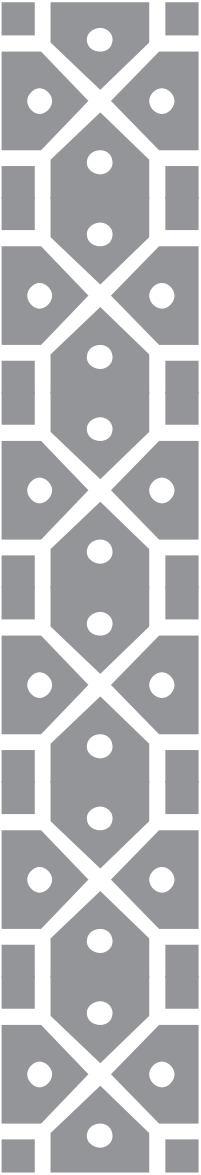
