ARCHITECTURE Machu Picchu

Machu Picchu, an ancient Peruvian city constructed of granite is considered one of the Seven Wonders of the World. Located high in the Andes, Machu Picchu was built to withstand natural disasters. Work with an artist to design and build a model of Machu Picchu.

One of the ways older ArtStart campers can turn their knowledge and skill learned in Camp CREATE into action,

knowledge and skill learned in Camp CREATE into action is to assist artists and staff as interns in ArtStart's Passport to Ecuador and Peru camp for younger children ages 4-12

years. Interns work side-by-side with professional teaching artists to assist in the classroom.
